Decatur Summer Reading Challenge

The research is clear that children who don't read during the summer can lose up to three months of reading progress and that loss has a cumulative, long-term effect (*Reading Rockets*). Here at Decatur, we know how hard our students work to progress during each year, and we want to encourage them to keep up the good work!

So to keep Decatur reading, prizes will be awarded to the class with the most time spent and the most pages read in each grade.

Each student will need to keep track of their time spent reading and the number of pages read (Decatur Summer Reading Log). At the end of each reading session/book, parents or guardians should initial the reading log. At the beginning of the year, each student will bring their initialed reading log back to their teacher. We will celebrate the class at each grade level with the most time spent and pages read. *And* we'll share all the things we have learned or wondered about through our reading. *Here's a list of suggestions to get you started on your summer reading journey:*
